It is not possible for the university to provide such specific information as doing so would make a student's identity easily traceable and would therefore exceed what can be released under FERPA.

Do the invoices for Drug Free Sports represent all the money spent on drug testing?

Yes.

Are suspensions mandatory on a first-time positive?

Suspensions are allowed but are not required.
