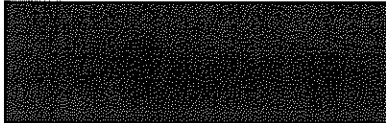

Dear [REDACTED]:

This letter shall serve as the official follow-up to the meeting we had in my office on October 1, 2004. During this meeting we discussed an incident report that alleges your involvement in a violation of the BGSU Code of Student Conduct. Based on our discussion and the information provided in the report, I charged you with one violation of the Code of Student Conduct, specifically section 6.d.1 that prohibits the following behavior:

*6 d 1 Offenses Disrupting Order or Disregarding Health and Safety
Use, possession or distribution of illegal drugs including the
use of drug related paraphernalia.*

This charge resulted from information regarding the results of a drug test administered on September 15, 2004 by the Department of Intercollegiate Athletics. The results indicate that evidence of illegal substances were found in your test results.

You accepted responsibility for this charge and therefore waived your right to a formal hearing before the University Discipline Committee. As a result the following sanctions are now in place.

You have been placed on University Disciplinary Probation. This probation begins immediately and will continue through December 20, 2004. During this time you may continue to take classes and participate in any and all activities and organizations. However, you must understand that should you be found responsible for additional violations of the Code of Student Conduct, you could face more serious disciplinary action, including suspension.

You must meet with Carrie Belair in the Wellness Connection in relation to the alcohol charge. You must contact Ms. Belair for an appointment, schedule and keep an appointment for no later than October 30, 2004. Appointments are made by calling 419.372.9355. There is a one-time \$100.00 administrative fee for the sessions with Ms. Belair that is due at the time of your first appointment (cash, check or bursar). It is expected that you will follow through on any and all recommendations that may result from this referral. Once the appointment is scheduled, you must attend.

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Failure to comply with these sanctions or involvement in any additional violations of the Code of Student Conduct will result in additional sanctioning which could include University suspension.

You have the right to appeal the sanctions indicated above. Should you choose to exercise this right, a letter of appeal must be directed to Dr. Wanda Overland, Associate Vice President for Student Affairs and Dean of Students; no later than five days from the receipt of this letter. Dr. Overland will review your appeal and issue a final decision regarding the sanction. Dr. Overland's office address is 301 Bowen-Thompson Student Union.

I understand that I may only appeal the sanction imposed by the Investigator to the Assistant Vice President for Student Affairs and Dean of Students in accordance with Section 10-b of the Code.
- I request that a formal hearing be scheduled with the University Discipline Committee on the charge(s) made against me.

We drug tested [REDACTED] on Wednesday, September 15, 2004 based on reasonable suspicion per the Department of Athletics Drug Testing Policy.

He has been suspended indefinitely from the Men's Soccer Program, his athletic aid for Spring 2005 has been removed, and he will be re-tested in approximately four weeks (the amount of time it takes for marijuana to clear your system). He is in violation of Athletic Department and University Policy. Therefore, I am now referring [REDACTED] to your office for further discipline. I have attached a copy of the positive drug test.
