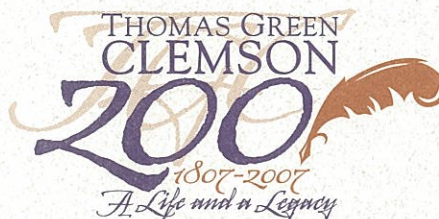

IN RE: FOIA Request

Mr. Carlisle:

President Barker has asked that I correspond with you regarding your request for records in your letter dated January 30, 2007. Our response relates to your itemized requests, as follows:

- 1) Documentation or an account of all positive tests can be found on page 23 of the enclosed document which contains the information for the 2005-2006 academic year. Data from previous years was lost when the pertinent office moved from one part of the campus to another. This loss of data is noted in the audit performed by Institutional Auditing (page 12). Clemson University Athletics Department policy is listed on pages 1-7.
- 2) A calendar or other documentation indicating the frequency of drug tests administered to athletes is not available. This information is maintained by our vendor and is not kept on campus.
- 3) Records relating to punishments levied for positive tests are located on page 23.
- 4) The budget for or amount of money dedicated to drug testing for fiscal or calendar years 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 is included on page 22 of enclosed document.
- 5) Audits or reports discussing the drug testing of athletes, excluding standardized information provided by other government agencies or the NCAA are included on pages 8-19 in the enclosed document.
- 6) Contracts or agreements with vendors who have a role in drug testing of athletes is included on pages 20-21 in the enclosed document.


