- Audits or reports discussing the drug testing of athletes, excluding standardized information provided by other government agencies or the NCAA.

The university will provide the above records but will redact any and all portions that constitute education records based on Government Code section 6254(k) and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and its implementing regulations (20 U.S.C. § 1232g; 34 C.F.R. Part 99).

- Contracts or agreements with vendors who have a role in drug testing athletes.
- All information provided by vendors the last time your institution put the drug testing of athletes up for bid or requested proposals.

We will provide copies of any contracts, agreements or information provided by vendors that are covered by the California Public Records Act. Any documents issued by the Athletic Corporation will not be provided. The Athletic Corporation is a private not-for-profit organization, and as such, is exempt from the California Public Records Act.

We anticipate the records will be available by August 8, 2007, and we will notify you of the exact page count at that time. The University's standard charge for copies is 20 cents per page, and you should make your check payable to California State University, Fresno.
