Dear Ron:

It was great seeing you again on Monday and Dr. Black and I really appreciate the time you, Dr. Scallise, and the rest of the team gave us. As we discussed, we are thrilled to have the opportunity to re-establish our relationship with the University Of Georgia Athletic Department and commit to do whatever we can to make the transition a seamless one. Below is a summary of the main points discussed in the two meetings.

Collection & Testing Protocol

We strongly believe that the changes to your collection procedures we discussed will be a true benefit to your program and relieve a significant burden from the collection teams. Based on our discussions, the following protocol changes are recommended.

- Conduct single bottle collection. A second test may still be requested since all positives samples are stored at Aegis for 365 days.
- Specific Gravity will be measured at Aegis, not at the point of collection.
- Ph will not be measured at the point of collection or at Aegis (not necessary).
- After the observed collection, the temperature is checked and the sample is poured off into the smaller bottle. Bottle is sealed and the donor initials and dates the label. Label is affixed to sample. Sample is placed into the bag with absorbent material. Chain of custody is completed and top copy is place in second pocket of bag. This should all take place inside the restroom on a table.
- After the collection event is completed, all samples are placed in a carton and the UPS Shipping Document is signed and affixed to the carton. If you are not a regular UPS pickup, call 800.742.5877 for pickup.
- If a sample is identified as a dilute specimen by Aegis, we will automatically reflex to a Dilute Specimen Reflex test, which will lower the test thresholds to

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compensate for the sample dilution. UGA will be charged only the #03304E Dilute Specimen Reflex Test fee (see enclosed Fee Schedule).

Drug-Free Sports Fee Schedule

The enclosed Fee Schedule lists the profiles we discussed along with associated fees. We hope that these fees will fit within your budget and will be happy to discuss them with you. The listed profiles include the following services at no additional fee:

- Forensic Sample Collection @ UGA Facilities utilizing your current collection crews.
- Collection Supplies, including: kits, forms, UPS air bills and lab packs, collection shirts and badges for collectors.
- Sample screening and confirmation for drugs of abuse and adulterants.
- School Policy and Procedures Review.
- Overnight shipping via UPS.
- Collection kits and forms.
- Results interpretation/consultation services with Aegis Toxicologists.
- 24-hour turnaround time for negative results.
- Random Program Administration (per UGA Protocol).
- Electronic results reporting (Email or auto fax.)
- Collector Training Session in Athens (date tbd).
- Continuing Education (NATA Breakfast, CATS Symposium, Big Sky Sports Medicine Conference, Campus Training Sessions, etc.)

Again, we appreciate the opportunity to make this proposal and welcome your questions, comments, or suggestions regarding it or any other aspect of our service. We are prepared to move forward with you at any time.
