Dear Mr. Carlisle:

Please find enclosed Indiana University's response to your January 30, 2007 request for records under the Indiana Access to Public Records Act, Indiana Code 5-14-3 et seq. The Indiana University Student-Athlete Handbook is responsive to your request for a "calendar or other documentation indicating the frequency of testing" and includes information on punishments levied for positive tests.

With respect to your request for "Documentation or an accounting of all positive tests as well as records relating to punishments levied," those documents and information are exempt from disclosure under the APRA pursuant to IC 5-14-3-4(a)(3).

With respect to your request for the "budget for or amount of money dedicated to drug testing for fiscal or calendar years 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007," the budgeted amount is \$15,000 per year for each of these years.

With respect to your request for audits or reports discussing the drug testing of athletes, there are no records responsive to your request.

With respect to your request for contracts and bidding information, there are no records responsive to your request.
