Dear Mr. Carlisle:

The following is in response to your public records request to the University of New Mexico dated June 28, 2007:

- *Documentation or an accounting of all positive tests.*
Since January 1, 2004, there have been 201 tests performed. Four have been positive.
- *A calendar or other documentation indicating frequency of drug tests.*
There is no documentation responsive to this request. Tests are performed on a random basis.
- *Records related to punishments.*
Attached are the Drug Testing Program Procedures, which include sanctions imposed for positive tests.
- *The budget or amount of money dedicated to drug testing.*
The Athletics Department pays UNM Hospital \$250,000 per year for all of its medical needs, including drug testing. There is no separate line item.
- *Audits or reports discussing the drug testing of athletes.*
There are no documents responsive to this request.
- *Contracts or agreements with vendors.*
