Dear Mr. Carlisle:

Please find enclosed all the documents that are on file regarding drug testing of athletes at Weber State University. There are four documents that show the dates when the drug testing took place and you will notice a notation by the athletic department indicating that tests are done once per semester with 10% of the athletes randomly chosen. You will also find another document of the one athlete who showed positive. The punishment was levied by the NCAA and the only documentation would have to be acquired from them. The punishment levied was one year loss of eligibility from the date the athlete tested positive and at the end of that year the athlete must be tested again at his own expense.

This, as indicated above, is all the documentation we have in our files relating to drug testing of athletes at Weber State University.
