Thank you for your letter of March 20 and the athlete drug testing information supplied with it. However, you did not provide records seeking accounting of all positive drug tests since January 1, 2004, as well as audits or reports discussing drug testing.

Can you please supply this information or explain why it is not available?

The UW Extension Local Government Center advises in its records law fact sheet:

"A written request must receive a written denial stating the reasons for the denial and informing the requester that he or she may file a "mandamus" action (or request the district attorney or attorney general to file such action) in the local circuit court seeking review of the custodian's determination and an order to release the record (see "Enforcement and Penalties" below). Sec. 19.35 (4) (b)."
